Feedback from Parent Questionnaires

Thank you to those parents that took the time to fill out our parent questionnaires. We received 50% of them back, which was great. We are keen to ensure that your voice is heard.

The vast majority of parents/carers are very pleased with our setting. Some points highlighted were: 'welcoming, friendly and approachable staff', 'children feel happy, safe and secure', 'free-flow access to outdoor area'. Other comments were 'fantastic staff and environment', 'varied range of interesting and stimulating activities', 'wonderful childcare centre'.

Oasis/British Values

We are working with the staff and children to promote positive Oasis/British Values. Each day at circle time the staff and children will reflect together about wanted and unwanted behaviour and how that makes the children and staff feel. Each week a child will be presented with an award for demonstrating positive behaviour and promoting the Oasis/British Values. This award will be promoted throughout the week and will be shared with parents on collection. Please speak to Briony if you would like more information about Oasis/British Values.

Toys from Home

Please can we remind parents to ensure that your child does not bring any toys, objects or play equipment from home into the setting via their bags. As the staff do not always have the time to check every child's bag, we are asking parents to take on this responsibility. Children will only be permitted to store comforters, nappies and a change of clothes in their bags.

If your child has an object of special interest that would support home to setting learning, please speak to a member of staff who will be happy to work with you to ensure safety procedures are put in place if necessary.

Nursery Rhyme Time

Starting from Wednesday 18.09.18, we will be holding nursery rhyme time in the toddler/pre-school every Wednesday from 11.15am-11.55am during the term time. Pre-school parents/carers can come into the setting and join in with nursery rhymes and stories with the children. Please speak to Briony if you wish to join the session.

If you have a child in the toddler/pre-school who does not attend on a Wednesday, you are welcome to come along with your child to join in with the session.

<u>Animal Day</u>

We will be celebrating Animal Day on Friday 4th October and learning about different animals from around the world. Your child can come into nursery dressed as their favourite animal if they wish.

Bring Teddy to School

On Wednesday 9th October we are celebrating Bring Your Teddy to School Day. Staff and children are invited to bring their favourite teddies into nursery. We will share stories and celebrate with a teddy bears picnic at snack time.

Outdoor Learning

We are really excited to announce that we are working alongside Marazion School and Jo Cooper, our Community Development Worker for outdoor learning, to develop an onsite Forest School area. The area will be accessible to both nursery and school children and will consist of community growing areas, outdoor cooking opportunities including a firepit and pizza oven, fairy dens, tree houses and sensory growing areas. The children will be able to free-flow into the forest school daily, providing them with endless opportunities to learn about fire safety, develop their confidence and selfesteem, learn how to manage their own risks and explore the natural environment to extend their knowledge and understanding of the world.
