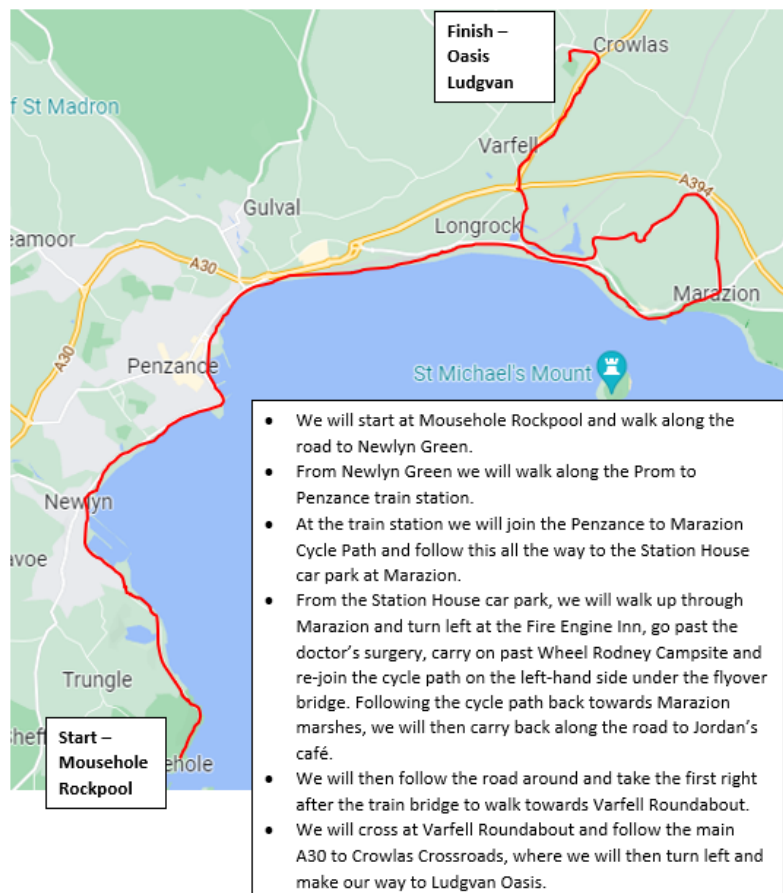
Dear families,
