We are continuing to work towards an Eco-Friendly Oasis and doing our bit to protect the earth.

Healthy Living - Our gardening project has supported the children's understanding of making healthy lifestyle choices. The children have taken on the responsibility to nurture and harvest their own carrots, peas, and potatoes. Fingers crossed for a good crop!

All children currently take part in a daily physical focus which promotes moving in different ways and learning about the benefits of regular exercise!

Waste and Recycling - Oasis children continue to take up the challenge of recycling paper, card, plastic and reusable materials. This has helped us to reduce 50% of the waste we produce each week!
